Call to Order: Meeting called to order at 7:01pm by Allison McBride.

Prepared for the Guest Speaker, Dr. Michael Herts, Chosen People Ministry and hosted him one night at the parsonage. Pastoral Care for several congregation members in grief and/or health crisis. Home visits for Holy Communion. Of course, all the regular assignments – Newsletter Article, Prep for Sunday Worship, and Sermons and PowerPoint slides.

Commission Reports:

Business Management: Reported by Jim Vinsand, please get in touch with Jim regarding any changes to the individual Commission budgets. October 7th is the 1-year anniversary for Michelle.

Properties: Reported by Mike Bruen, the Tuck Point was finished. They charged us for twenty stones and fixed 47. They used all the stone that we owned, so we are out. Unfortunately, they found approximately 200 more stones that are damaged. The area in the Bell tower has some of the worse damage. The company will work with us on a progressive plan to fix the damage. Mike may look at a trip to Mankato for more stone. They also worked on the Cross on the east side. There is some Spalling which is breaking, chipping, peeling or flaking of concrete. We will try to get the parsonage painted also this fall. The Norwegian Supper is 75% sold out.

Education: Reported by Allison McBride, Confirmation Sunday is October 26th, Rachel will teach Sunday School on that date. It is different from when it was announced in the Newsletter and the Bulletin. We will have Pastor on Sunday make the announcement change. We will change it in the Bulletin. No Sunday School the Sunday after Thanksgiving. We will have the Children's Christmas Program on December 14th during church. There will be a practice on December 9th and the 13th. The Christmas Program will follow the True North Vacation Bible School theme. Sara will call all of the children who went to Vacation Bible School, who don't come to church regularly to ask if they would like to participate in the program. Renae asked if we will be serving Breakfast after the Christmas Program? She will ask Sara. Michael added if they needed help with that, Membership & Outreach would not mind helping out.

Youth: Reported by Brent Larson. We will have a Youth Craft/Game Day after the Christmas Program on Dec. 14th at 10:30am. Brent reminded Abee that the First Presbyterian Youth are welcome to participate in the monthly youth events at Badger Lutheran Church. We had a youth event on October 5th. We played games and did crafts. The next youth event is November 9th. We will have a can drive to benefit the local food bank. He is waiting for Winter Jam concert tickets to go on sale. The "Monster Jam" monster truck show is Saturday, April 11, at 1 pm at the Casey's Center in Des Moines. Tickets go on sale October 14th. Brent is looking for someone to volunteer to drive and chaperone for this trip to Des Moines since he is unable to participate.

Worship, Music & Arts: Reported by Abee Kelleher, Abee asked when would be a good date to decorated the church for Christmas. We will make an announcement for volunteers for December 7th. Michelle will be in charge of ordering Poinsettias.

Membership & Outreach: Reported by Michael Hendren, nothing to report.

Missions: Reported by Renae Gebers, she shared the date on Facebook for Feed My Starving Children Mobile Food Pack which is December 6th. They are excepting new Mission request. The deadline for that is December 15th.
